o2 Produktion invests an additional SEK 1 billion in wind power

o2 Produktion, co-owned by Proventus and the o2 Group, has completed its first wind power park and signed development contracts for another three parks.

In mid-January 2008 o2 Produktion completed its first wind power plant, Röbergsfjället Vind, located in Vansbro municipality in Dalarna, central Sweden. Today, Röbergsfjället Vind is Sweden's largest onshore wind power park.

– We are pleased to announce that the park has been completed on time and on budget, says Thomas von Otter, CEO for o2 Produktion.

The Röbergsfjället Vind park consists of eight Vestas V90 wind turbines and has an expected annual electricity production of 50 GWh, which corresponds to the annual consumption of about 10 000 households. The investment amounts to approximately SEK 220 million.

In addition to this, o2 Produktion has over the last six weeks signed development contracts for another three wind power parks: Säliträdberget Vind located in Mora municipality, Hedbodberget Vind in Rättvik municipality and Bliekevare Vind in Dorotea municipality. The total investment amounts to approximately SEK 1 billion and has an expected aggregated annual electricity production of 200 GWh.

In connection with the completion of the wind power park, Hedbodberget Vind will direct two of its wind mills to Rättvik municipality and two wind mills to o2 El Ekonomisk Förening, a co-operative within the o2 Group.

o2 Produktion has the ambition of investing another SEK 1-1.5 billion in wind power during 2008.
